FYE-100 Life Unpacked (2 credits)

This class provides first-year students with support and guidance in a variety of skills and practices necessary to becoming a successful college student. The course covers studying and note-taking skills, library and research skills, and making an effective transition from high school to college. The class also features a series of presentations from faculty in various disciplines within the General Education curriculum, designed to introduce students to the various academic possibilities and career paths for majors, minors, and electives. Finally, students in the class will participate in a number of cultural events.

FYE-101 Career Discovery Lab (1 credits)

This is not your average class. It's a fun, no-pressure way to figure out where you're headed in life, and how to get there. We'll explore real careers in healthcare, business, sports, psychology, and more. You'll learn how AI and tech are shaping the jobs of the future. And you'll leave with more clarity, confidence, and curiosity than you started with. This course is designed for students who aren't 100% sure what they want to do yet (which is almost everyone!), and students who think they know what they want to do but aren't exactly sure what that means (what will I be doing?!).
